The super hero pastor who has super powers to create a miracle for them with or without God. The fact that is missing today, is that Christians fail to understand what it means to be rooted in the

Word of God so that no matter what the enemy throws at them, they will hang unto the promises of God for their lives.(Jeremiah 29:11).

I always say this to people, when you call me about an issue you are facing I go to God to plead your case. My first argument is "God your child is in trouble". Imagine how it feels when someone else has to tell your parents you need money, when they are with you all the time. There is a place for prophesying over people, speaking into people's lives but the ultimate issue is the individual having personal relationship with God

In my ministry I have seen many Christians who are tired of moving from one place to the another, one deliverance after the other, sowing seeds after seeds believing that breakthrough would come and its still not coming. If you are familiar with what I am saying, with readiness in your heart for a change, then let me take you on a life-transforming journey that is guaranteed to manifest the promises of God in your life in the next couple of days.

I have seen many people being blessed by God through deliverance, some received their major breakthroughs and they have shared outstanding testimonies. Because of lack of knowledge, many do not know how to maintain their blessings and as a result the enemy creeps back into their lives and steal the blessings they've just received. Many people fail to understand that it is not only about the miracle, but God who brings about miracles.

I am very excited about this book, because I believe it will bring about change into your life to stay on course and be focused on your destiny. Not only that, but you will become in touch with The Creator, and no matter what challenges you are faced with you will stand your ground base on the knowledge and the fact that no matter what happens your victory was secured a long time ago by Jesus Christ.

If you are still reading, it means that your desire for change is deep. So let us agree in prayer as we embark on this journey. I pray that God will give you the grace to follow through and be obedient to His Holy Spirit, to help and direct your footsteps until the end in Jesus mighty name, Amen and Amen.

Chapter One

There are no accidents

First and foremost, let us agree that nothing happens by accident or by chance. Everything happens for a reason. Everything that happens in this world is provoked, activated or initiated by somebody so please don't leave anything to chance. What we call miracles are the works of the right hand of God. So miracles don't just happen else it would've been called coincidence. A miracle is a supernatural act of God. God decides before acting. With this we can boldly say there are no coincidence either.

<u>B</u>lessings and curses do<u>n</u>'t just happen, they all happen as a result of a deliberate action or mistake. The challenges and the curses that <u>have</u> torment<u>ed</u> many believers over the years are as a result of the actions of those who lived before them. The covenants that were made, the altars that were built and the sacrifices that were offered all activated curses that we experience today. Some of these curses come as a result of our own actions.

Similarly the blessings that we enjoy today have come as result of our actions or of those before us. No matter how you look at it, something happened to provoke what is happening in your life.

As the result of Adam's actions, sin was brought into the whole world, on the other hand Jesus' actions brought redemption to the whole world. "For since by man came death, by Man also came the

resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. (1 Corinthians 5:21-22) "

In the book of Genesis 49: The bible tells us that the twelve sons of Jacob were blessed based on their actions in the past. The Bible is inundated with exemplary scriptures like this. This shows that indeed the world that we live in operates on cause and effect, which means to get a reaction you must act first. We have all been in a place or situation where you are praying and it seems as if nothing is happening. FST. But sometime later you begin to see the results of that prayer, sometimes we have to be reminded by the Holy Spirt about the prayer before we remember, because it didn't feel like it was working so we forgot about it.

It is a law of attraction. Based on this knowledge it is safe to say that whatever is happening now will cause something to happen in the future whether good or bad. And Joshua said to the people: "Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." (Joshua 3:5). Whatever you do today has an effect on your tomorrow.

The Love of God and the Blessing's of God

God's love for us is unconditional; it is unmerited, it is just, immeasurable and there is absolutely nothing you have to do to deserve God's love. (For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16)

The scripture does not say for God so love Christians or any particular group of people, it say the world. For the bible says that He make the sun shineth on the good and evil and sendeth rain on the just and unjust. However, regarding the blessings of God, the bible makes it clear that they come with conditions. To receive them, you must earn them. This does not mean that God is selling them to you. He has already made them available for His children but we have a responsibility to bring the blessings into existence into our lives.

To enjoy the blessings of salvation, we need to believe first and confess according to the scriptures:" For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation....For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Romans 10:10-13).

To understand the blessings of God, if you 'proof read' on these scriptures there is a clear message that something has to be <u>understood</u> and put to action done to make things happen.

Deuteronomy 30:15-, 11:26 "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God. (Deuteronomy 28:1-2)

You have a responsibility

If the blessings of God come with a condition and it is not the same as the love of God, which is unconditional, then it means that we have a responsibility as Christians in receiving our miracle and our breakthrough. We have a responsibility and a role to play.

For instance, let us talk about prayer. We have to pray to God for answers with the help of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> who intercedes with us. Praying is our responsibility, with the help of the Holy Spirit of cause. It is high time Christians understood that God has given them authority and dominion on earth, and that in order for God to do anything on earth, we as His children need to provoke His help. We cannot blame the pastor, our parents or our friends... no we have the responsibility, a role to play. In the book of *Isaiah 1:19 the bible says "if you are willing and obedient you will eat the good of the land"* meaning to be ready to do our part. If you are not enjoying something that God said you will enjoy, then surely there is something that you are not doing that He said you should do, for God`s word has no fault.

God created everything by His Word. God swears by His Word and so if it is written in the word, it is what God say it is. God wants us to abide in His word. If you look in the book of Deuteronomy God spoke to the Israelites and told them that if you obey my commandments these blessings shall follow you but if you don't then this curse will come upon you. We have a responsibility and that is why I am bringing out this booklet to empower you, to say that there is something that we can do.

The bible says in Genesis 1:26 that God created man in His own image and He said let man have dominion. So we have dominion on earth. Have you ever sat down to think why Jesus Christ had to become a man and die just to save us? It is because God made man to rule the earth and that is exactly why everything that happens here on earth has to do with man. Man has to bring in divinity. So you have a responsibility, you have something that you have to do to provoke the blessings of God. The <u>reason for our shortcoming is</u> because of lack of knowledge and understanding of our position with God. From now on, you are going to forget about the cause of your offense, it does not matter who offended you. In fact you have no right to take offence, for the bible says: That in this world we will be offended, woe unto the one who brings offence. We need to admit our responsibility and a role we need to play so as not to hinder blessings in our lives. Look at the woman with the issue of blood and the blind man who begged Jesus to have mercy on him. They did something in order to receive their miracles. They were not offended by the actions of those around them. Nothing should stand in your way, not even yourself.

The laws of focus

Most Christians are hindered by their lack of focus. In my journeys I have met a lot of Christians who are praying about one thing or the other, and then you meet them after a couple of years later and they are still praying about the same thing. Most of the churches I have been to in the past, sometimes when I go back to visit I don't find those people anymore and you hear that they are not in church anymore. We should

be like Job and say "I will sit here until my change has come". Christians nowadays only come to God for what they can get. They become so impatient and put God on a test. It is very common to hear people say "if God doesn't come through for me by the end of this month, if I don't get my blessing that's it! I am done"!!!! Where are you going? What are you going to do if He doesn't come through?

Focus is very vital in achieving the best in our Christian life. The people we are going to be looking at in the next chapter were people of divine focus. God will not come through for you just because you prayed once, you have to be focused and be consistent in prayer. The bible says in the book of James 1:8 that everyone who is double minded should not expect to receive anything from God. Yes you are praying and you are not seeing anything, keep on praying. The bible says that Elijah continued in prayer he did not stop. Elijah continued praying and he kept on sending his servant to go and check to see if there was any sign of rain and when he didn't see anything, Elijah did not give up. He stayed there and continued praying until he saw what he was looking for.

So you have prayed for it, its not happening, you prayed one year it didn't happen, you prayed one month it didn't happen; what then? Do you give up? The answer is NO! We have to on the answers we are looking expecting. Whatever you are believing God to do for you, whatever promises you have received from God should be guiding system for the rest of the journey.

Like Paul said to Timothy, "remember the prophesies that went out to you, by it you wage a good warfare'. In other words the promises and prophecies that you have received are meant to help you to stay on course, remain focused and direct your footsteps. The prayers you have prayed, the desires of your heart, the seed you have sown should propel you to remain on course as you hold steadfastly onto Gods promises. Keep praying and don't just give up. Elijah would not come down until the young man told him that the rain was coming.

The problem with inconsistency in any aspect of life is that it always leaves you so many unfinished projects. When we lack consistency in our prayer life it becomes difficult to walk in victory and attain our spiritual maturity. Like with anything in life, when we do not get results we will soon tire, or we will end up getting into a vicious cycle of starting and stopping. You might have been praying for marriage and six months down the line you are still not married. The devil will keep reminding you that you are still single. He brings that to your attention because he wants you to believe that God will not answer prayers, he wants you to give up. But the faithfulness of God should motivate you keep on praying and believing because if you stop now few weeks later you will be back praying the same prayers.

Chapter Two

World changers

In this chapter we will be focusing on people who changed their situations. The kind of people who refused to remain in the same position; Influential people who changed their environment. Primarily, our focus would be on heroes of faith in the scriptures. These heroes are the people that deserve our respect, appreciation and to be celebrated, for their attribution in their life time through perseverance.

I have carefully selected these heroes of faith for a reason; these heroes of faith didn't receive a prophecy or promise for victory. They just got up and activated change in their lives. Most of us today have received prophecies, dreams, visions about what we praying and believing God for. Let their lives motivate you to activate change.

1. The Prodigal Son: Also known as the Lost Son - you might wonder why I am starting with the prodigal son. It is mainly because he is not regarded as a hero by many and he is not credited for anything. In my opinion the prodigal son should inspire a lot of us. If he was not that important Jesus himself would not have told his story. Lets take a look <u>at</u> the book of Luke 15:11-32. The bible says that the prodigal son took everything that his father gave to him and he spent it. Many in their lifetime <u>have</u> wondered off from the grace of God, took off on their own, in their own understanding <u>and</u> they left behind a great relationship with God the Father. In their shame they believed that they did not have what it takes to be called child<u>ren</u> of God again. The bible says that he went to live in the slums leaving behind a life of royalty. He lived there for a while until his inheritance vanished. When he became so poor, the bible says, he took a job to feed the pigs so he could feed himself with the same food he fed to the pigs.

He had lost everything. The bible says in Luke 15 that he made a decision and that became his game changer instantly. He activated change in his life. When he came to his senses he asked himself, "what am I doing here? There are servants in my father's house and they are serving my family 3 course meal, I am working hard and I am dying". In that very moment, he made a decision and he got up and started walking home. He went home to his father where he left with everything against his fathers will but because of grace he made it back.

Many of us can relate to this scenario. Most people left their countries to come to Europe for greener pastures. Unfortunately things did not go as we planned, but because of the impression we left where we came from, some of us cannot go back home because they will feel humiliated. You find yourself caught up between a rock and a hard place. You feel dirty, you feel rundown and you feel like you are a nobody and you have left a very bad name behind. Look at the prodigal son, he decided to go home. Am sure there <u>are</u> many things that tried to distract and discourage him but he was focused and determined to go home. If we can have that kind of determination and despise everything the enemy throws at us, we will be unstoppable.

The bible says the father was sitting down on the porch and saw him from afar, with his arms stretched out he ran to meet him and he kissed and hugged him. The son tried to explain himself to his father but the father didn't care about any of that. All he wanted was for the son to be home.

Now this should tell us that the miracle this young man needed was always there waiting for him. The father could not go into the slum but

he was waiting for the day that the son will say enough is enough. The day that you say enough is enough is the day that your father gets up and say now is my time to protect my son, now it's the time to bless my daughter, now it's the time to put a robe on my child. The father cannot do that until you decide that enough is enough. Until you decide that enough is enough you will never know that you still have one more move you can make or one more thing that you can do. The prodigal son is our first example because he took an action to change his situation. Every hero of faith that we are going to look at took an action and said enough is enough and provoked change. This is what this book is about; for you to be able to say I have had enough and take a step towards home and provoke the change that you are looking for in your life.

2. Esther: The bible says that the Israelites in those days were caught up in a situation where the enemy was trying to get rid of them entirely. Esther's uncle, heard about the plot and decide to talk to Esther about it that she needed to do something about the situation lest they get destroyed. Her uncle told her that the only way she can do something is for her to speak to the king being her husband. Esther was a queen whose predecessor disrespected the king in the presence of his friends while they were drunk and his friends advised that if he didn't do anything about it , it will only show that he was a weak king and for that reason the king got rid of his wife.

Now Esther's uncle asked her to go see the same king without being invited into his presence which was forbidden. Esther decided to go into fasting and prayer before taking the next step. She said she would walk in after the fast believing that God would come through for them and if God doesn't come through then she was ready to die. The bible says after the fast Esther walked in there in the presence of everybody and when the king was supposed to be angry he saved her and her people. God was already in there holding his heart. The bible says

Proverbs 21:1 The heart of the king is in the hand of the Lord, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

Esther found favor in the eyes of the king instead of dying. If Esther didn't get up to do anything, destruction would have come and all the Israelites would have been wiped off. Do you realize that Esther made history and today we celebrate her because of that one decision that she made? She decided to get up and said enough is enough, we have <u>been</u> in the minority for a long time and I am going to get up and do something, I am going to get up and do something about this situation' and God who is their father was already waiting for their action.

What I am trying to make you understand is that God has always been moving since Genesis Chapter 1 and He is always ready to move, we just have to align ourselves with His will. Esther just went into the will of God and did what she was supposed to do and God came through for her. God honors His word. God saved His children. If God did it for Esther, He can do it for you. Activate change in your life. Don't let fear grip you. The fear of failure, no! If you sit there and not act you are going to die anyway. If you sit tight nothing will happen and nothing will change, you will remain in the same situation and you will be destroyed. Act and God will come through for you.

3. The 4 Lepers: The bible says that these lepers had been sitting outside the gates of Israel. They were starving. Why? Because there was famine in the land and they were lepers .The bible says that all the people in Israel were inside the city and nobody was doing anything to provoke the hand of God. One day of the lepers said look we have been sitting here doing the same thing and we are dying of hunger. Why don't we get up and do something different'. They needed to activate change. They decided to get up and go into the next city. They knew that they were lepers and they are not allowed to mingle with people but they also knew that they were going to die if they didn't get up to do something about their hunger. They also knew that if they

go they will die and if they don't do anything they will still die but at least they wanted to do something.

What you are going through in your life might be painful but I am very certain that it's not as bad as what the leapers were going through. The price that they were willing to pay for their breakthrough was their lives. They purposed in their hearts and said 'we are willing to die for this'. The bible says that when they got up to go, God had already gone ahead of them. Angels of God were already on the grounds waiting for them to come and when they arrived the angels matched with them and 'the footsteps of the lepers' made so much noise that the enemies became scared and they ran and left everything. So for all the time they were sitting there starving, others killing and eating children, there was abundance of food and even jewelry in the next city waiting for them. God has already prepared a blessing for you. Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. When you get to a place and you are stuck, trust me, there is always one move you can make and God will honor your step of faith. The bible say that when they made that move it brought change and I am certain that is what brought change to the entire nation of Israel. The nation of Israel experienced change because somebody had had enough. Activate change. Take a step and God will come through

3.4. King David: David became a great hero and even up to today there is still a tomb of David. After David had been anointed, what brought him out to shine in the limelight was his victory over Goliath. When we look at the life of_David we also see him activating change. The bible says that for a while Goliath had been tormenting the armies of Israel and nobody could do anything about it. He used to come out to provoke and insult them and nobody could get up to fight him. Everyone was afraid of him. David came from tending the sheep and when he saw the man, he asked the people whom Goliath was. They told

him that they were under attack being abused and humiliated and nobody could help. David got up and decided to do something. It doesn't_matter what situation you are in, whether you are out of work, you don't have papers of you are in a humiliating position, nothing is supposed to stop you_from fulfilling your destiny.

David's brother was upset with him saying that David was arrogant and this was because of what David was about to do which nobody was willing to do. David was willing to do something different, he was activating change. David knew whom he trusted. He knew that God was with him and he knew the outcome. The bible says that David got himself prepared and went against Goliath, Goliath asked him 'am I a dog that you are coming against me with stones' but David said to him 'I am coming to you in the name of the Lord of Israel whose army you have defiled and today He is going to hand you over to me and I am going to kill you'. You have been a bigger champion all your life, you have been tormenting Israel all this while and the only reason that happened is because you have been dealing with a group of people who don't know what it takes to provoke the hand of God while I on the other hand I am here to activate change. The bible says David got up and went up to Goliath and slain him. I have taught this in my teaching about the battle of the gods that there was an angel behind Goliath that killed him.

From the day you started facing challenges in your life, from the time the enemy started tormenting you God already sentenced him to death. An angel has already been dispatched to destroy your enemy as you are reading this. If you can just put this book down for a minute and stand up and say 'Father I am ready for change. Let destruction come to every enemy, everything that has been a hindrance' I promise you in the name of God you will see it come to pass. David went after Goliath and killed him.

As you can see from the above examples none of them heard anything from God and some of them didn't even have the Holy Spirit in them. They just got up and did something and God came through for them. David didn't say 'God said'. He saw a problem that had been there for a while and nobody was willing to do anything about it but he acted and God honored his word. Get up and make a move, God is waiting for you to take action while you are sitting there saying you are waiting on God.

The challenge (ENGAGE)

For the next 21 days we are going on journey that will not only bring deliverance and breakthroughs but will also change your life forever. We are going to use these spiritual exercises and godly habits, which we call COVENANT WORD ACTION.

I know you are very familiar with all the topics in this section but I want you to be open-minded and have the willingness to receive from God by carefully following the instructions here. Even though you might be familiar with the topics here am very sure you will learn few things that will add to what you already know.

Remember we are doing this for 21 days that means repeating most of the Covenant Word Actions for 21 days. Not every single day is going to be smooth, you might have a few hiccups here and there but the most important thing is to get back on track as soon as possible.

1. Fasting: - What is fasting

Fasting is abstaining from food and drinks or either for religious purposes.

What happens when you fast? We all know that when you fast you bring your body under submission for your spirit man to become active and have dominion. When we don't fast frequently we give our bodies the preeminence in our lives. Our body doesn't communicate with God. It is only our spirit that communicates with the Spirit of God so in

order access what God has for us we need to bring our flesh under subjection.

There are different types of fasting according to the bible. I often ask people to fast according to their strength or what the Holy Spirit has instructed. Many Christians misunderstands the whole concept of fasting. Some use fasting to show how matured they are or how powerful they are, whiles fasting contributes to maturity and spiritual exploits, it is not the measuring stick for both.

Don't get me wrong I believe every Christian should fast regularly but I believe like anything else it should be done with proper understanding in order for it to be profitable. When I got saved newly, I spent time around Christians who liked to boast of how many days they just spent in a dry fast. I also started fasting likewise so that when the matured ones started talking I would also have something to say. I did take it to the extreme which brought some concerns to those around me. Later on I came into contact with a man of God I have always admired whom God was using for mighty signs and wonders. One day he mention that he hasn't gone on a long dry fasting in all of his life. He went on further to explain that during his time of fasting he spends more time in intense prayer (about 13hours), which makes it difficult to go on long dry fast. I've seen Christians who fast for weeks but cant pray for more than 3 hours non stop. But in the end it's about what works for you and what God has graced you to do, lets not forget that we are graced differently.

For the purpose of this program let's look at these three types of fasting.

 Absolute fast: which is abstaining from drinks and food for the duration of the fast. I do not recommend this kind of fasting for more than three days.(Esther 4:6)._Saul when the Spirit of God came upon him, he became blind and stop eating or drinking for 3 days(Acts 9:9)

- 2. Partial fast: this type of fasting is where you can eat fruits in the evening for the duration of the fast. Prophet Daniel spent 3 weeks fasting from certain foods, Daniel : 10.
- 3. 3.Regular fast: this type of fast you can break in the evening with any type of food. There are those who can't make it to the evening if that's you try and at least make it to 3pm. This is the type of fasting Judah's king Jehoshaphat called for when his country was confronted with invasion 2 Chronicles 20:3

2. Bible Studies

In this section we are going to deal with bible studies. For the next 21 days of activating change I want you to really immense yourself in the word of God. You see many Christians nowa-days during time of fasting and prayer don't normally spend time in the word because the main reason for the fast is the need so as long as we are praying we think that's it. I always tell people that without the word of God your fasting is very dangerous. Why, because the word of God during the time of fasting has 3 different purposes.

- A. The word of God becomes your guide and when you receive a revelation during the time of prayer and fasting you can always look it up in the word of God. During your time of prayer and fasting your spiritual man is open to the spiritual realm and therefore there is a lot that goes on around that time. I have seen people go on fast and get things from their flesh and think they are from God. So when you are praying it's important that you spend time in the word and in the scriptures. Otherwise if you are praying and you don't have the scripture how will you know if your revelation is based on the word!! So that's what it's important for your time of fasting and prayer.
- B. The word of God is also the prophecy. When God gives you something you write it down and you have the word as the final authority on everything. The Bible says God honors His word above His name. So the word of God is the final

authority so when God speaks to you and gives you a word you will also have His written word to back what He is saying to you. The Word of God says faith comes by hearing and by hearing the word of God so by that word you run the race.

C. The word of the living God is like a mirror. The bible says that Moses met with the word of God and when he came down from the mountain his face was so shiny that the people had to use veil to cover their faces. We are viewing the word of God without any veil so as we read it we are transformed from Glory to Glory. In other words we look at the word of God and as we confess it will we become one with the word. So when the word comes and lives in you, you are transformed by it and you become one with the word. So for the next 21days I would like you to read through the daily bible reading attached to the So please during this time make sure you confess the word and soak yourself in it until you see the manifestation of it.

Service unto God.

Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. (Psalms 37:4)

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. (Matthew 6:33)

One thing that guarantees reward in the kingdom of God is service. When you serve God in any capacity God is obligated by your service to bless, protect and prosper you. The bible talks a lot about the reward of the laborer. It doesn't only refer to those called into ministry, it's for all of God's children.

If secular companies know how to take care of their staff how much more God. When Peter asked Jesus about it He said each one that works for God will be rewarded in this life and the after life. Each time you meet a kingdom need or over a kingdom service, it is credited to

your heavenly account. And when your cloud is full you cannot be denied of your rain.

God will keep His workers in good health so they continue to work for Him, God will deliver His workers so they can have peace of mind to work, God will prosper His workers to help advance the gospel. Hezekiah's life was extended because of service unto God, David's throne was established because he wanted to build a temple, Dorcas was raised from the death because of her service etc.

For the next 21 days find something you can offer as a service unto God even if you are already servicing church I want you to go an extra mile during this time of activating change. Go out on the street and evangelize, share the good news with somebody. If you will put your shyness aside and win souls for God will remove every obstacle between you and your blessings. If it means helping to clean the church, joining the children's ministry, help with the homeless, dedicating onehour a day to intercede for souls and the church just do it. Whatever it takes to become a busy body for Jesus this season.

Sermons and Audio Bible

I want to encourage you to stay off television and other things that take your time and rather invest in listening to sermons and audio bibles.

You can find many teaching on my website and youtube or listen to messages from other anointed men of God whose ministries y-agree with prayer and fasting. I would recommend you just listen to my messages on prayer and fasting during this season.

There are different levels of listening to messages. The type am asking you to do is to soak in the message, that's listening to that one sermon until you receive an impartation from the message. Replay the message over and over. You meditate on the word every chance you get.

With technology at our fingertips, most phones have audio bibles. Make use of them; listen to audio bible when going to sleep and when you wake up. I have messages I have been listening for years now and I still listen to them even though I almost know it word by word. I have been listening to book the of John for months now and it's blessing me so much. Invest in your spiritual life and buy anointed materials.

Always make sure that you have a spirit filled book you are reading during this 21 days.

Confessions and Prophesies

In this session we want to deal with confessions and prophesies. These are confessions and prophecies that you will be declaring during the 21days of activating change. Before we go any further I would like to explain the difference between confessions and prophesies. They are not the same thing. You see confession and prophecies are different in the sense that prophecy is an inspired word that comes from God.

Now I am not going to go deeper into that but for the sake of this teaching I would like to make you understand that prophecy is speaking something that is from the mind of God regarding something in your life.

Prophecy is speaking something that is not there physically, we prophesy it for it to come to pass. So when we talk about prophecies we say what the Lord is saying. The Lord says tomorrow about this time there is going to be this or that, it is not there yet but it is going to happen as declared. Unlike God's word that is already there, that is settled in heaven. When God speaks in heaven it needs a human force to manifest it on earth and therefore even though God has done it in the spiritual realm, it needs us humans with our free will to declare it and make it come to life.

The bible says God will not do anything except to reveal it to His prophets. So because the thing hasn't already been done on earth, it has already been done in the spiritual realm, God needs His prophet on earth to declare what has been revealed to him so that it will be manifested. That is prophecy.

On the other hand, confession is personalizing that which has been prophesied, claiming it and declaring it until you see the manifestation. We often say we are what the word of God says, I always say that the statement is not entirely true because the word of God says so many things that we are not. We are what we say we are. We introduce ourselves to people by our names and the name you say you are that is the name people will use to address you and to them that is who you are. It is because you told them that is who you are. So when it comes to confession we are confessing what the prophetic word of God says regarding our lives and we are accepting it and confessing it by faith to say I am the head not the tail because Christ came to die for the sins of the whole world.

Christ came to die for the present day evil.

Now that mean the death of Christ is the best news to the whole world, and it should be the end of every problem but we are not seeing that today. Until the world takes a step towards Christ and accept the salvation that He is offering, until the world confesses and accept the salvation they will not partake of the blessings that God has prepared for us. Until then, they cannot become God's children. That is confession. It is there already, it is there for you to just confess it and be it. You are what you confess according to the word of God.

So for the next 21 days you are going to confess. I don't know the challenges you are facing. I don't know what it is that you want to see happen in your life but for the next 21 days, you are going to make a confession based on what God has promised you in your life. Look for the scriptures that talk about what you want. The bible says beloved I wish above all, that you would prosper even as your soul prospers. If it is prosperity you need, you know that it is the will of God that you prosper. He says that the silver is His and the gold is His. He says ask of Him and he will give you the ends of the earth as your inheritance.

Also make a conscious decision not to say anything negative about your situation no matter what happens. Should you do so mistakenly try and

immediately refuse and cancel it then speak what the scriptures say. Counter attack every negative word with a scripture.

So in these 21days use these scriptures to speak into your future, speak into your destiny. You are your own prophet for this season and I pray and release the spirit of prophe<u>cy</u> upon you from this day forward in Jesus name. Amen.

Prayer:

BELIEVER'S DAILY PRAYER

The bible is full of different prayers. The difference between each one of them is their purpose. In the Believers Daily Prayers we are going to deal with prayers that was prayed to help believers in their daily walk.

The fact that these prayers were written down in details means they are not just to be prayed once but should be repeated daily. The apostle Paul says that he was praying them continually for the early church. These are not prayers that are prayed as request for things but they are meant to change Christians into being what the word of God expects them to be. If these prayers were prayed for believers then we must pray them constantly. I have outlined 7 prayers that I believe we should pray constantly.

Prayer for faith. (Luke 22:32, Luke 17:5)

I believe this is one of the most important prayer every believer needs because it is basically prayer for survival since our walk is a walk of faith. The disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith because they were dealing with something that their faith could not handle. Our faith can either grow or die. The enemy comes against our faith the same way he came against Peter but just as Jesus prayed for Peter's faith to be restored is the same way we should pray for ourselves and others in faith.

Prayer: Father increase my faith above every circumstance, I come against every attack on my faith. Father give me the grace to stay in your word.

The grace to do the will of God (Hebrews 13:20-21, Phil. 2:13)

The walk of faith can be challenging without the help of God. The above scriptures show us that there is help in prayer to enable us do that which is right before God. We are faced with different issues everyday. There is always a need to make decisions daily and since we live here on earth most times its only what will satisfy the flesh that is easily achievable. We need to pray constantly to be able to make the right decisions that will please God and help us to make destiny.

Prayer: Father equip me with the grace to do your will and to do whatever I need to do to fulfil my destiny.

Prayer for divine wisdom (Ephesians 1:17-23, Col. 1:9)

Divine wisdom is above that of the world and it belongs to us if we ask for it. We need divine wisdom to manoeuvre our way around in this world. We are saved to be ahead of the world not to follow their examples. Jesus tells us to be smart because the world we live in is wicked and it's only by divine wisdom that we will avoid the traps of the enemy and make strides in life.

Prayer: Father give me divine wisdom In Jesus mighty name

Prayer for growth in God (Revelation). (Ephesians 1:17-23, Col. 1:9)

To walk in power and authority in Christ Jesus means we need to know God very well. Everything has been made available for us by Jesus but we have to know the man Jesus and the will He left for us. Prayer makes us powerful because when we pray we are drawn into His presence and our strength is renewed and when scriptures become alive in us or revealed to us, then Christ is manifested through us. (Mind and body elimination)

Prayer: Father give me the spirit of revelation and understanding.

Prayer for Spiritual Strength. (Ephesians 3:16)

The need for spiritual strength is very important. Sometimes it is difficult to activate out faith when we feel weak or we are presented with a hopeless situation. (Faith is about taking bold and courageous steps and you have to be strong to take those steps). The enemy will throw many things at you, you need to be strong to stay focused. (See also Ephesians 6:13)

Prayer: Father give me the strength to be able to stand my ground no matter the challenge or temptation.

Prayer for increase of Love. (Phillipians 1:9, John 13:34)

Jesus has commanded us to walk in love, and as a matter of fact thats the new commandment which He gave to us according to John 13:34. Sometimes it is not easy to walk in love especially when dealing with barbaric situations but our perfect example Jesus loved even those those that crucified Him. Love grows and love dies but we have a life giving Spirit in us so we must pray through the spirit for our love to increase.

Prayer: Father let your love fill my heart, cause me to grow in love in all things I do, say or think.

Commit your daily activities to God. (Prov. 3:6, Ps. 37:5)

I added this one because I believe we should always commit our steps into the hands of God. On a particular day your schedule might look like it doesn't have anything special planned but still, talk to God about your day, everyday before leaving your house. Children of God are to be led by God (Roman 8:4). And since God will not intrude in something we have not committed to Him, we must make it a lifestyle to always commit our steps into His hands.

Prayer: Father I commit my day into your hands, I commit every step I take today into your hands, please direct my footsteps in all things in Jesus name I pray.

Spiritual development for personal growth-

My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Proverbs 4:20

Here are few personal spiritual exercises that has helped me grow and overcome many challenges at different times. These exercises have worked for ME time and again and I trust it will work for you too. I pray for the grace to help you keep these exercises to help your walk with God.

> 1 Tim. 4:8, For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

> Prov.18:1- Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh and intermeddleth with all wisdom.

The above scriptures help prove the point that it takes a personal decision to make a difference in your life. Athletes discipline themselves to train for what they what to become. So to become what you are not at the moment requires you to make a decision for change and ask for the grace of discipline and consistency.

Remember CONSISTENCY is a very powerful tool to making a difference so in this exercise CONSISTENCY is the key. No matter what happens don't break this routine no matter it costs you. Trust me its very easy to break the routine with any excuse but very difficult to pick up sometimes up to years to come back.

I once broke my prayer routine to help a pastor friend start a ministry, I never got back to that prayer routine and the ministry never succeeded. This is something I regretted for sometime so am pleading with you

from my heart please follow these instructions religiously as if your life depends on it for the next 21 days and it will become your lifestyle.

- 1. Keep prayer appointment with God daily- Daniel 6:10-11
 - a. Find a nice and quiet environment
 - b. Choose a time you can keep each day and stick to it (possibly 4am-6am)
 - c. Saturate the environment with nice and calm worship song if possible
 - d. Keep distractions afar. Turn of phone or any other form of communication
 - e. Let your heart and mind be on God and keep worship in your heart. Take it seriously knowing that God is waiting for you.
 - f. Keep with you bible, notebook and pen to write down your experience
- 2. Pray in tongues at least 1hr a day without asking God for anything in your understanding. Write whatever comes to you during your prayer
- 3. Do at least 30min prayer walk a day.
- 4. Read at least 4 chapters a day starting from the book of Acts
- 5. Share the gospel or the revelation you received with somebody.
- 6. Always have a book you are reading.
- 7. 6 Fasting at least once a week, (up to 6pm), one week of the month and once 24hr absolute fast a month.

Guard your mind by what you spend time watching and listen. Listen to many sermons over and over. If any negative thought starts to dominate your mind open your mouth and speak against it.

You don't do anything without thinking so always stop negative thoughts by rebuking it before it becomes actions.

21 DAYS PRAYER POINTS FOR ACTIVATING CHANGE

but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits. (Daniel 11:32b)

For the next 21 days we are going to fast and pray than ever before. If you want God to something that He has never done in your life, you need to do something that you have never done before

Looking the above scriptures both in Daniel and 2Kings, both require the candidate to have a strong connection with God in order for the impossible to become possible. Daniel says those that know their God and 2nd Kings says the hand of the Lord came upon Elijah. We cannot spend all our time on TV, phone, internet and friends and then expect the supernatural to happen, no it doesn't work that way. Whatever you fill your time with you become full of it, so if you spend your time with the Holy Spirit you become full of the Spirit we read about in the book of Acts. The same way if you spend your time talking with friends and the internet you eventually become a gossip or busybody.

I want to implore every son and daughter of mine to make time during this fasting and prayer, let everybody around you know that you are going to be busy for a while if possible switch off your phones and TV's during fast as much as you can. These days technology has become one of the devil's distractions. I want you to fast away things that easily distract you, if it's your phone turn it off during the time of prayer turn it back on for few hours a day unless it has to do with your

work. Return calls that are important and don't spend too much time with TV as well.

Try your best and pray around the clock, start your day with prayer and finish it with prayer. Between 12 midnight and 2am should meet you in prayer, please make sure you don't go to bed on heavy stomach if possible eat fruits and <u>warm</u> beverages when you break your fast. In as much as you make time for these also make time to study the word and meditate and also wait on the Lord for inspiration.

Precious one Pray, Pray and Pray for with God nothing is impossible.

DAY 1:

Daily Bible Reading- Romans 1-5

And Jesus having earnestly beheld, said to them, `With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.'

Matthew 19:26

- 1. Thank God for your life in Christ, thank Him for seeing through the difficult times in your life.
- 2. Ask for to forgive every sin in your life
- 3. Ask God to empower you to go through this fast and not miss out on His blessings.
- 4. Pray and receive the power to breakthrough to the next level in the name of Jesus.
- 5. Come against every mountain of impossibility in your life.
- 6. Command them to be leveled in the name of Jesus.
- 7. Ask God for the grace to focus on your breakthrough despite contrary reports.
- 8. Take authority over those things that have troubled your mind and bring it to submission in Jesus name.
- 9. Specifically mention the names of situations that has bothered you and command them to turn around in Jesus mighty name.
- 10. Thank God for making the impossible possible; thank Him for the new breakthroughs in your life.

11. Thank God for answered prayer in every aspect of your life.

Prophetic declaration: I speak fresh fire into your life as you embark of this journey, I declare peace into your life. I declare your victory is already secured in Jesus mighty name.
